
# 402 BOSTON AVE RETAIL + RESTAURANT OPPORTUNITIES



#### PROJECT ORIENTATION


402 Boston Avenue is a newly constructed residence hall that will house 664 Tufts University students. It is situated along one of the busiest corridors in the neighborhood which connects the dense residential neighborhoods of Medford, Somerville, and Arlington. This new mixeduse building also sits across the street from the new MBTA Green Line station and adjacent to Dowling Hall, which is the main entry building and parking garage to the Tufts campus welcoming a blend of students, faculty, residents and visitors from around the world.

The retail and restaurant opportunities at 402 Boston Avenue present a rare opportunity to join the Tufts University community while also benefitting from the dense residential neighborhoods connected by this busy corridor. Completion of the building will be in Summer 2027, with students occupying the residences upstairs for the Fall semester.


