Emblem 125 is a mixed-used residential building located in Providence's central and rapidly developing Jewelry District, featuring 249 luxury apartment homes and 19,458 square feet of ground floor retail.

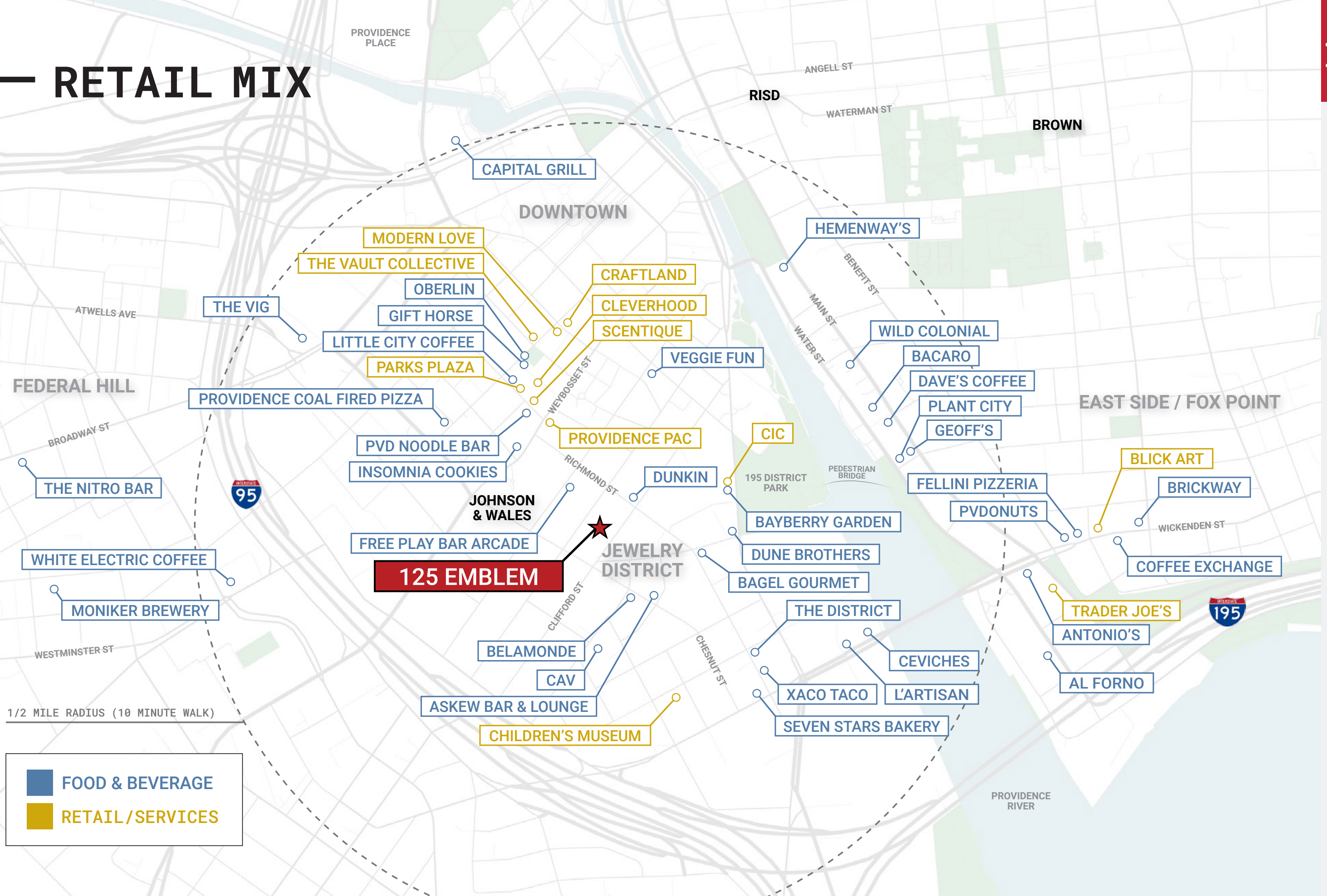

Anchored by a highly-visible restaurant space on the Northeast corner of the building, the balance of available retail space can accommodate a mix of uses including local shops, services, and amenities.

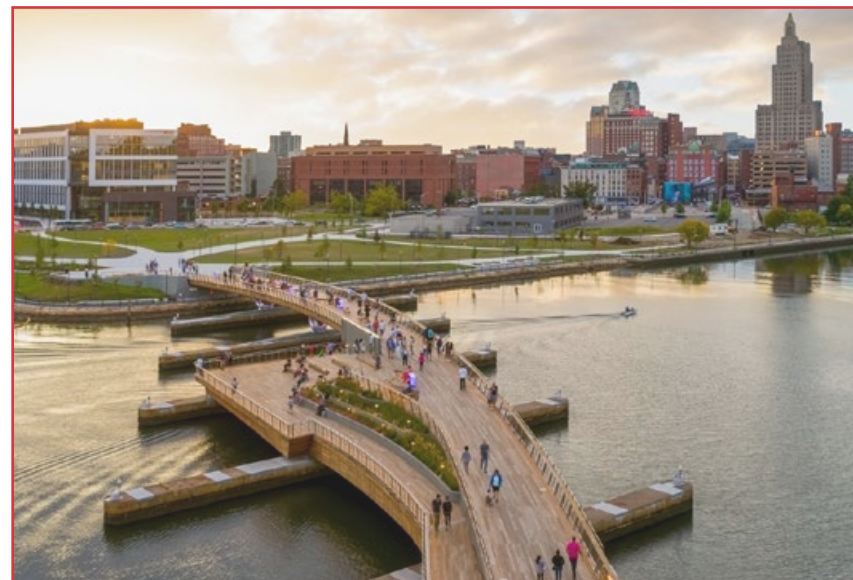
